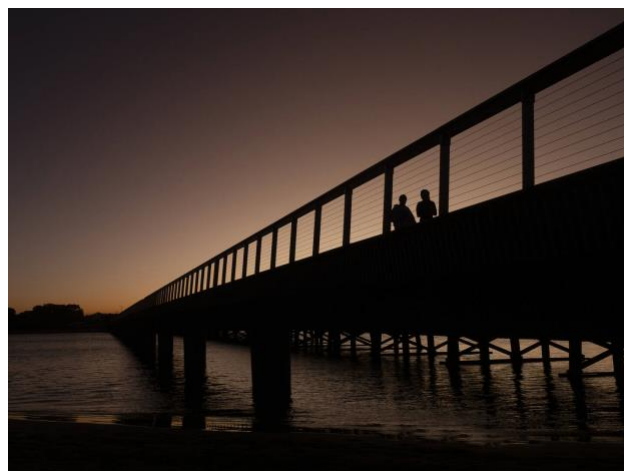

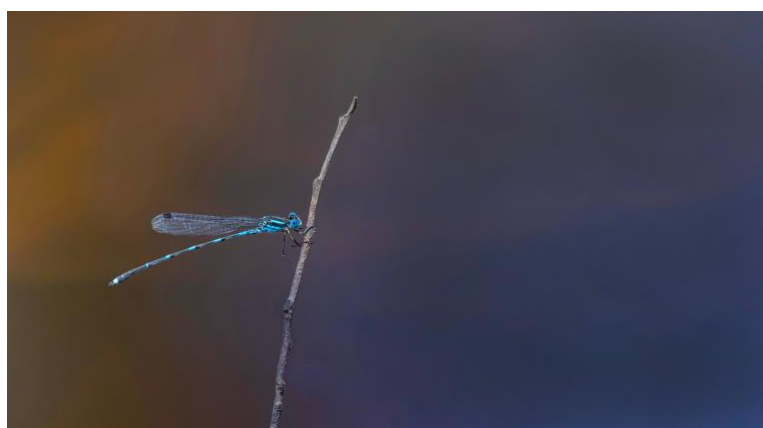

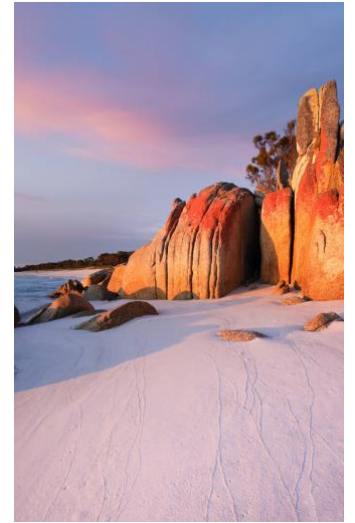

VALE MARK BEVELANDER

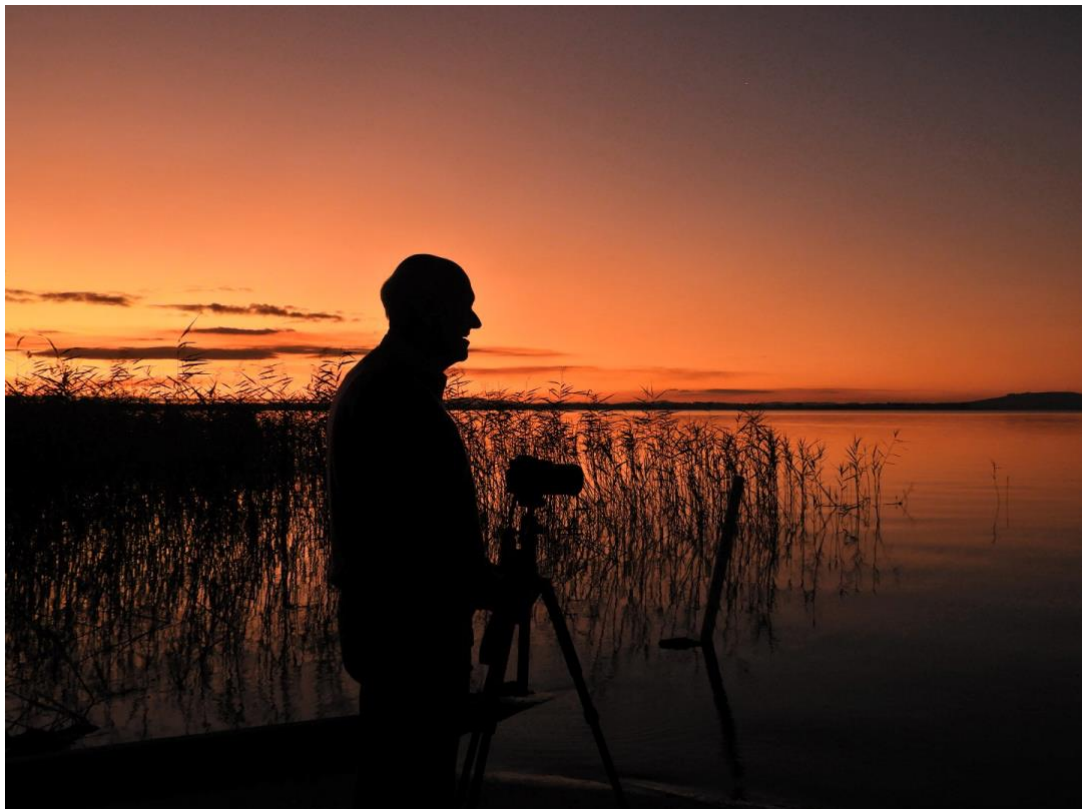

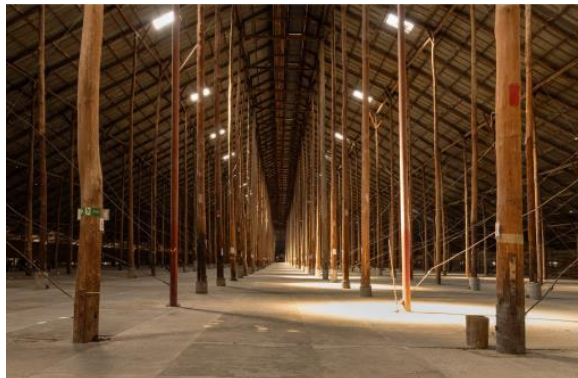
